

PIANO STUDIO POLICIES

Thank you so much for being part of the studio. It's a joy to work with each of you, and these guidelines are here to help create a smooth, consistent, and supportive experience for everyone.

LESSON STRUCTURE & TUITION

Lessons are organized in eight-week blocks. Tuition is due at the beginning of each block.

MAKEUP LESSONS

Each student is offered one makeup opportunity at the end of the eight-week block to account for a missed lesson during that time.

Because the studio schedule is quite full, I'm not able to rearrange or make up lessons beyond this designated makeup time. Any additional missed lessons are forfeited. Thank you for your understanding—this helps me keep things fair and consistent for all students.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

Students are encouraged to arrive on time and ready to begin. This helps us make the most of each lesson together. Lessons will still end at the scheduled time, even if a student arrives late.

ILLNESS & WEATHER

If a student isn't feeling well, we'll simply move the lesson to Zoom for that week. The same applies during inclement weather.

To make this transition easy, it's helpful to have Zoom installed and updated on a device at home so we can continue lessons without interruption.

PREPARATION & MATERIALS

Students should bring their books and materials to each lesson. Clean hands and short nails are also important so that we can focus on healthy, comfortable technique at the piano.

PRACTICE EXPECTATIONS

Regular practice—even in short, consistent sessions—makes a tremendous difference. Students will get the most out of their lessons when they come prepared and ready to build on the week's work.

FOR YOUNGER STUDENTS

For younger students, a bit of parent involvement at home can make all the difference. Helping establish a routine and supporting practice time sets students up for success.
